BOYS PRE – K – 6TH GRADE

DAILY UNIFORM

Pants – long navy
Shirt – white or light blue knit, or white
 or light blue oxford (long or short sleeved)
Sweater – red or navy cardigan or pullover
Socks – white, navy, or black (crew sock only **no ankle socks**)
Shoes – **SOLID BLACK NON MARKING ATHLETIC**
Belt - black

OUTDOOR OR CASUAL UNIFORM

Pants – blue jeans or navy uniform
Shirt – RHBS t-shirt
Shoes – Athletic (**any color non-marking**)
Socks – same as daily
Belt – same as daily

GIRLS PRE-K – 6TH GRADE

DAILY UNIFORM

Jumper or culottes-(length to knee) *
Blouse - white middy or shirtwaist
Sweater – cardigan (red or navy)
Tie – plaid or navy – with white middy blouse
Pants – navy with middy blouse or shirtwaist
 blouse (optional)
Socks or tights – white (knee highs), navy, red, or hunter green or tights
Shoes – saddle oxfords (black or navy on white),
 or **NON-MARKING SOLID BLACK ATHLETIC SHOES**
 or **SOLID WHITE ATHLETIC SHOES**
 NO MARY JANES

OUTDOOR OR CASUAL UNIFORM

Pants- blue jeans or navy uniform (**No skinny jeans**)
Shirt – RHBS t-shirt
Shoes – athletic (**any color non - marking**)
Pants – navy with middy blouse or shirtwaist
Belt - black

- In order for the PLEATS on the girls uniforms to lay nicely, wash with mild soap in cold water, and line dry. **DO NOT DRY IN DRYER OR USE FABRIC SOFTNER.** This will remove pleats.

HAIR ACCESSORIES

BOYS:

1. Hair style should not be below the collar, no wedge haircuts, and no part of the head may be shaved. This would include having no appearance of “Rock” culture, or other sub-cultures, in style, cut or color (no peroxide).
2. Pants should not be tight or baggy.

GIRLS:

1. Jewelry – earrings must be studs only and 1 pair per student. No necklaces can show outside the uniform. The staff has the authority to require the removal of any inappropriate or distracting jewelry being worn by the students.
2. All skirt lengths must be to the knee when the student is standing.
3. Girls must wear shorts under jumpers.
4. Only clear nail polish is acceptable.
5. Make-up is not allowed.
6. All hair accessories must be the same colors as those in the uniform.
7. On chapel days girls are required to wear the uniform jumper or a skirt and blouse.
8. Hair must not cover the eyes and must be natural hair color.

UNIFORM POLICY

Pre-K – 6th Grade

1. All uniforms are to be purchased through Parker Uniforms at 2108 NW Military Hwy.
2. When wearing our uniform, it must be a full and correctly worn uniform with no partial wearing of uniforms.
3. All school rules of appropriate Godly conduct apply when a student is in uniform, no matter whether they are on or off campus.
4. All items will have to be labeled with the student's name.
5. **Winter coats may be worn to and from school, however, in the classroom students will be required to wear the uniform sweater or the uniform jacket.**
6. Field trip dress is as the teacher advises.
7. Failure to comply with the uniform policy will necessitate corrective actions. First a warning, and then a call to bring the correct uniform to the student.

BACKPACKS & LUNCH BOXES

Are to be SOLID COLORS WITH NO CHARACTERS OR PRINTS, INSECTS, ANIMALS ETC. on them. Trying to keep out all the negative influences has become so time consuming this will greatly assist us in this area.
